International Formation Session, 21-23 July 2018



A true "universal church"

With a record-high participation of 54 couples and 19 Spiritual Counsellors from 43 countries throughout the world, the sessions were run by 5 formation couples and two spiritual counsellors. The sessions were simultaneously translated into 5 languages and were developed around the Word of the Gospel of St John, Chapter 14:1-7, "I am the Way, the Truth and the Life."

In 5 formation modules the following topics were treated: Father Caffarel and the Sacrament of Marriage, Conjugal Spirituality, the Role of the Regional Responsible Couple, Collegiality, Internationality, Mission. Besides the talks, and within a beautiful liturgical framework, there were also moments of prayer, dialogue, reflection and the exchange and sharing of experiences in mixed team meetings.



The international formation sessions had specific goals:

Moments of prayer and communion

- Contribution to the formation of future Regional couples
- Reflection on the importance of Father Caffarel's thinking on the sacrament of marriage
- Reflection on the call to service and how to experience it fully
- The understanding that the Region is the communication and communion point between the Sectors as well as between the Region and the SR
- Exchanging ideas and experiences on the role and function of the Region
- Understanding the importance of collegiality and internationality within Teams
- Delving deeper into the meaning of the mission of a Responsible Couple
