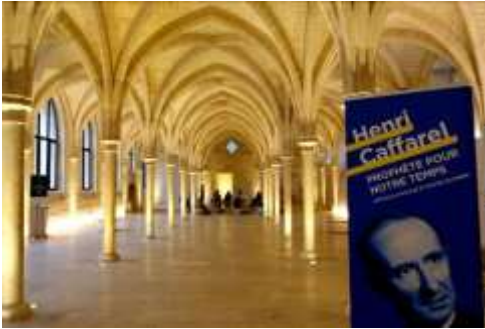
**We were delighted to celebrate the 55th wedding anniversary of our Responsible Couple, To & Zé!**

## Life of the Movement

**The great event that marked the month of December was the International Colloquium on Father Caffarel held at the College des Bernardins in Paris, on December 8th & 9th, 2017**

## Update on Work in Progress or Finished Work

### **Satellite Teams:** *Work presented by Clarita & Edgardo Bernal*

☞ The SRs/RRs will be asked to reflect and think of the most important subjects to be dealt with by the Satellite Teams in the years to come, so that they might be discussed during mixed Team meetings at the Fatima College.

Two platforms (**Christian Formation & Database**) are operational (with the exception of a few translations for the former).

The **Orientations for 2018/2024** will be defined by the new Responsible Couple collegially with the current ERI.

**The topic for Longstanding Teams** is being finalised by Graça & Roberto. The ERI will validate it during its April meeting so that it can be distributed at Fatima in July. Similarly, Françoise & Rémi are preparing **The Pilot Couple's Guide** that will be developed and circulated in the same timeframe.

The revision of **The Guide to Teams of Our Lady** is almost finished and will be ready for Fatima.

The document "**Vocation & Mission at the Beginning of the Third Millennium,**" prepared by To & Zé, is being finalised. It will be worked upon collegially at the next ERI meeting and will be circulated at Fatima.

**Assessment of the Intercessors:** Mahassen & Georges revealed that the Movement now possesses correspondents in all Super-Regions and this is an encouraging finding.

## Perspectives

### **Preparation of the 2018 Fatima Gathering, the International College and the International Session**

The **programme** (conferences, testimonies, liturgical celebrations, opening and closing ceremonies, group activities...) has now been definitively fixed.

All the **speakers' texts** must now be sent to the International Secretariat **immediately**, so that the translations and publishing of the booklets can be done in time.

**Solidarity** has worked well and has enabled countries without sufficient financial resources to help their Team members attend. The global amount of aid is 250 000€.

There will be **simultaneous translation** for 6 languages: Polish has been added to the Movement's 5 official languages.

**The Gospel of the Prodigal Son** (Luke 15:11-32) will be the Gathering's "common theme." Every day will have a title relating to a verse from this Gospel: *Freedom—Dissipation—Repentance—Mercy—Celebration*.

**Registration** began on September 15<sup>th</sup>. Some countries, who did not reach 80% of their quota by December 15<sup>th</sup>, had their quota decreased by 20% to allocate the places to smaller countries who were looking for places. End of registration is January 15<sup>th</sup>.

The **International College** will be slightly shortened because of the Gathering that follows. Its "common theme" will be from John's Gospel "**Remain in my love.**" (Jn 15:7-10)

The SRs/RRs will receive a letter asking them to select participants for the **International Formation Session** that will take place after the Gathering in Fatima.

**Succession of the current ERI:** the choice of successors for the different responsibilities is underway ... Information will be made available during the first quarter of 2018... The official handover of services will take place at the closing of the Fatima Gathering.
